\*I/Each of us also understand(s) that if \*I/we misconduct \*myself/ourselves at or in the vicinity of the polling station or within the no canvassing zone/no staying zone or fail to obey any lawful order of the Returning Officer or the Presiding Officer, \*I/we shall commit an offence punishable with a fine and imprisonment and may be ordered by the Returning Officer or the Presiding Officer to leave the area immediately. \*My/Our failure to leave such area may result in \*my/our being removed by a police officer or a person authorised in writing by the Returning Officer or the Presiding Officer, as may be appropriate. If \*I/we are so removed, \*I/we may not re-enter the relevant area on the polling day except with the permission of the Returning Officer or the Presiding Officer.

# 填寫就非位於監獄內的投票站委任監察投票代理人通知書說明

## Notes on Completion of Notice of Appointment of Polling Agents for a Polling Station Not Situated in a Prison

- 除非候選人以指明表格明文另作示明,有關代理人須當作是為在預定日期進行的投票和(如適用的話) 於遭押後的該次投票而委任。
  - The agent is to be regarded as being appointed for the poll to be conducted on the scheduled date and (where applicable) the postponed or adjourned poll, unless the candidate expressly indicates otherwise in the specified form.
- 2. 候選人或其選舉代理人可在該候選人獲提名的選區內,就每個非位於監獄內的投票站**委任不超過 2 名 監察投票代理人**。凡年滿 18 歲的香港身分證持有人均可被委任為監察投票代理人。候選人可委任同一人 為多於一個投票站的監察投票代理人,但須在第一部分填寫有關的投票站名稱。如果某人被委任為所有 供該選區選民投票的非位於監獄內的投票站的監察投票代理人,請在第一部分填寫 "所有"。候選人或 其選舉代理人不應委任任何選舉主任、助理選舉主任、或任何已受總選舉事務主任委任協助進行投票或 點票的人士(通常為政府公職人員)為其監察投票代理人。

A candidate or his/her election agent may <u>appoint not more than 2 polling agents</u> for each polling station not situated in a prison in respect of the constituency for which the candidate is nominated. Any person who is a holder of a Hong Kong Identity Card and has attained the age of 18 years may be appointed as a polling agent. Candidate may appoint the same person as a polling agent for more than one polling station but the name of the relevant polling stations should be put in PART I. If a person is appointed as a polling agent for all the polling stations not situated in a prison for polling by electors of the constituency concerned, please put "ALL" in PART I. A candidate or his/her election agent should not appoint any Returning Officer, Assistant Returning Officer, or any person (usually a government officer) already appointed by the Chief Electoral Officer to assist at the poll or the count as his/her polling agent.

- 3. (a) 就每名候選人而言,在候選人、其選舉代理人或其監察投票代理人中,同一時間內只限**一人**停留在 一個投票站內監察投票。因此,如候選人或他/她的選舉代理人正停留在投票站內,則該候選人的 監察投票代理人不得同時停留在投票站內。
  - For each candidate, only **one** among the candidate, his/her election agent or his/her polling agent(s) may be present in a polling station to observe the poll at any one time. Therefore, when a candidate or his/her election agent is present in a polling station, a polling agent of that candidate shall not be present at the same time in the polling station.
  - (b) 投票站主任可以規限可進入投票站的候選人、選舉代理人或監察投票代理人的數目。如可容納該等人士的指定範圍已滿座,投票站主任可拒絕該等人士在該等時間進入投票站。
    - The admission into the polling station of a candidate, election agent or polling agent is subject to the overriding power of the Presiding Officer to regulate the number of persons admitted to the polling station. If full capacity of the area inside the polling station designated for such persons has been reached, the Presiding Officer may refuse further admission of such persons to the polling station at that point of time.
  - (c) 進入投票站的指定範圍監察投票一般採用先到先得的方法。假若在同一時間內要求進入指定範圍的 人數超額,將以抽籤決定進入的先後次序。
    - Admission to the designated area of the polling station to observe the poll will normally be on a first-come-first-served basis. If the number of persons seeking admission at the same time exceeds the capacity, then lots will be drawn to determine the priority of entry.
  - (d) 獲准進入指定範圍的人士,只可在指定範圍內逗留<u>一小時</u>;除非其後在指定範圍內的人數並未滿額,亦無其他人士在輪候進入該範圍,否則他/她必須離開。每位進入投票站指定範圍的人士須在投票站職員保管的簽到冊簽到並記錄進入時間。
    - A person will only be allowed to stay in the designated area for <u>ONE HOUR</u>, thereafter he/she must leave unless the designated area is not fully occupied and no other person is waiting to be admitted. Every person admitted to the designated area of the polling station is required to sign in and enter the time of admission on the log book kept by the polling staff.
  - (e) 當指定範圍所能容納的人數額滿時,輪候的每位人士會獲發一個號碼籌,以記錄指定範圍有空位時他/她獲准入內的次序。當輪到持有某一號碼籌的人士進入該範圍時,投票站人員會在投票站入口讀出該號碼。如該號碼持有人當時並不在場,則持有下一個號碼籌的人士會被獲准進入指定範圍。當缺席的人士再次回到投票站外時,便須重新領取另一號碼籌輪候。
    - When the designated area is full, each person waiting to be admitted will be issued a number chit in sequence to record the order of his/her entry to the designated area when a vacant seat arises. When it is his/her turn, his/her number will be called outside the entrance to the polling station, but if he/she is not present at that time, then admission will be granted to the one holding the next number chit. Such an absentee will have to obtain another number chit and join the queue afresh on his/her return.

(f) 如候選人或其代理人要求進入投票站但直至投票結束前的所有等候時段已滿,即沒有空缺的時段可以分配給該候選人或其代理人。然而,如該候選人或其任何一位代理人均未曾於投票日進入該投票站觀察投票,相關的投票站主任會盡量透過特別安排給予該候選人/代理人於投票結束前進入該投票站觀察投票的機會。在這特別安排下,如果獲分配最後等候時段進入投票站的候選人或其任何一位代理人,已曾於較早時獲分配時段於該投票站觀察投票,上述要求進入投票站的候選人或其代理人將會取代此人,獲分配該時段。

If a candidate or his/her agent seeks admission to a polling station but all the waiting slots are full until the close of poll, no vacant slot can be allocated to the candidate or his/her agent. However, if none of this candidate or his/her agent has earlier entered the polling station to observe the poll on the polling day, the Presiding Officer concerned will endeavour to give the candidate/agent an opportunity to enter the polling station to observe the poll before the close of poll under a special arrangement. Under this special arrangement, the person will replace the candidate or his/her agent who has been allocated the last waiting slot for admission to the polling station if this last candidate or any of his/her agents has already been given an earlier slot to observe the poll at that polling station.

PART I of the notice should be completed and signed by the candidate or the election agent. PART II should be completed and signed by each of the polling agents.

5. 委任監察投票代理人的委任通知書,須於投票日前的第7天或之前(即2019年11月17日或之前)藉專人送遞、郵遞、電子郵件或圖文傳真方式交付予有關選區的選舉主任,或於投票日,由候選人或選舉代理人親自交付予監察投票代理人所負責的投票站的投票站主任。逾期遞交的通知將不予接納。監察投票代理人的委任,在選舉主任或投票站主任(視何者適用而定)接獲委任通知書後始生效。

Notice of appointment of polling agents must be delivered to the Returning Officer for the relevant constituency by hand, by post, by electronic mail or by facsimile transmission at least 7 days before the polling day (i.e. on or before 17 November 2019), or be delivered by the candidate or the election agent in person to the Presiding Officer of the polling station for which the polling agents are appointed on the polling day. Late submissions will not be accepted. The appointment of polling agents will not be effective until notice of appointment is received by the Returning Officer or the Presiding Officer, as may be appropriate.

#### (a) 資料用途

就此通知書提供的個人及其他有關的資料,會供選舉管理委員會、選舉事務處、有關選區的選舉主任、 有關投票站的投票站主任及其他有關的政府部門用於與選舉有關的用途。

#### **Purpose of Collection**

The personal data and other related information supplied in connection with this notice will be used by the Electoral Affairs Commission, the Registration and Electoral Office, the Returning Officer for the relevant constituency, the Presiding Officers of the relevant polling stations and other related government departments for election-related purposes.

#### (b) 資料轉介

就此通知書提供的個人及其他有關的資料可能會提供予其他獲授權的部門或人士,包括但不限於法院,用於與選舉有關的用途。

#### **Transfer of Information**

The personal data and other related information supplied in connection with this notice may be provided to other authorised departments or persons including but not limited to the law courts for election-related purposes.

#### (c) 索閱個人資料

任何人有權根據《個人資料(私隱)條例》(第 486 章)的條文要求索閱及改正他/她所提供的個人資料。

#### **Access to Personal Data**

A person has the right to request access to and correction of the personal data he/she supplied in accordance with the provisions of the Personal Data (Privacy) Ordinance (Cap. 486).

#### (d) 個人資料保障原則

候選人/選舉代理人在收集第三者的個人資料以填寫此通知書時,須遵守《個人資料(私隱)條例》 (第 486 章)附表 1 的保障資料原則,特別是第 4 原則,即採取所有切實可行的步驟,以確保資料受 到保障而不受未獲准許的或意外的查閱和處理。

#### **Personal Data Protection Principles**

Candidates/Election agents are reminded to observe the Data Protection Principles in Schedule 1 to the Personal Data (Privacy) Ordinance (Cap. 486) in collecting personal data of a third person in completing this notice, in particular Principle 4 concerning the requirement to take all practicable steps to ensure that personal data are protected against unauthorised or accidental access and processing.
