

**Registration as the  
Architectural, Surveying, Planning and Landscape  
Ex-officio members of the Election Committee**

**1. Who is eligible to be registered**

With reference to section 5A of the Schedule of the Chief Executive Election Ordinance (Cap. 569), you are eligible to be registered if you are holding one of the following Specified Offices -

<b>Specified Office</b>
(1) the President of The Hong Kong Institute of Architects
(2) the President of The Hong Kong Institute of Surveyors
(3) the President of The Hong Kong Institute of Planners
(4) the President of The Hong Kong Institute of Landscape Architects
(5) the Chairman of the Hong Kong Housing Authority
(6) the Chairman of the Town Planning Board
(7) the Chairman of the Board of the Urban Renewal Authority
(8) the Chairman of the Hong Kong Housing Society
(9) the Chairman of the Antiquities Advisory Board
(10) the Chairperson of the Property Management Services Authority
(11) the Chairman of the Community Involvement Committee on Greening
(12) the Chairman of the Advisory Committee for the Fire Safety (Buildings) Ordinance and the Fire Safety (Commercial Premises) Ordinance
(13) the Chairman of the Harbourfront Commission
(14) the Chairman of the Land and Development Advisory Committee
(15) the Chairman of the Lantau Development Advisory Committee

**2. Points to note**

- (a) If you are a holder of one of the above specified offices (“specified person”), you may submit your application by completing the form **“Application by Specified Person for New Registration as Ex-officio Members of Election Committee” (REO-EC(X2))**;
- (b) If you are a holder of one of the above specified offices but are not eligible to be registered because –
  - (i) you are not eligible to be registered or are disqualified from being registered as an elector for a geographical constituency;
  - (ii) you are a principal official appointed pursuant to a nomination under Article 48(5) of the Basic Law, a directorate officer of the Government, an Administrative Officer of the Government, an Information Officer of the Government, a police officer; or any other civil servant who is holding an office specified in the official capacity; or
  - (iii) you have submitted an application to be registered as an ex-officio member as a holder of another specified office,

you may designate another person who is holding an office in a relevant body in relation to the specified office (“Designated Person”) to be registered as an ex-officio member. You may submit the application by completing the form **“Application by Designated Person / Council Chairman or Chairman of the Board of Governors of the relevant University for New Registration as Ex-Officio Members of Election Committee” (REO-EC(X3))**.

The form must be signed by both the specified person and the designated person; and

- (c) Each person may only be registered as an ex-officio member for one specified office.
