

**Registration as the
Social Welfare
Ex-officio members of the Election Committee**

1. Who is eligible to be registered

With reference to section 5F of the Schedule of the Chief Executive Election Ordinance (Cap. 569), you are eligible to be registered if you are holding one of the following Specified Offices -

Specified Office
(1) the Chairperson of the Executive Committee of the Hong Kong Council of Social Service
(2) the Chairperson of the Social Workers Registration Board
(3) the Chairman of the Council of the Institute of Social Service Development
(4) the Chairman of the Board of Directors of the Tung Wah Group of Hospitals
(5) the Chairman of the Board of Directors of the Po Leung Kuk
(6) the Chairman of the Board of Directors of the Yan Chai Hospital
(7) the Chairman of the Board of Directors of Pok Oi Hospital
(8) the Chairperson of the Board of Directors of Yan Oi Tong Limited
(9) the Chairman of the Executive Committee of The Lok Sin Tong Benevolent Society Kowloon
(10) the Chairman of the Board of Directors of New Home Association Limited
(11) the Chairperson of the Board of Directors of Social Workers Across Borders Limited
(12) the Chairperson of the Board of Directors of The Hong Kong Volunteers Federation Company Limited
(13) the Chairperson of the Council of The Hong Kong Federation of Trade Unions Hong Ling Society
(14) the Chairperson of the Executive Committee of The United Labour Chi Hong Association Limited
(15) the Chairman of the Board of Directors of The Hong Kong Island Social Services Charitable Foundation Limited

2. Points to note

- (a) If you are a holder of one of the above specified offices (“specified person”), you may submit your application by completing the form **“Application by Specified Person for New Registration as Ex-officio Members of Election Committee” (REO-EC(X2))**;
- (b) If you are a holder of one of the above specified offices but are not eligible to be registered because –
 - (i) you are not eligible to be registered or are disqualified from being registered as an elector for a geographical constituency;

- (ii) you are a principal official appointed pursuant to a nomination under Article 48(5) of the Basic Law, a directorate officer of the Government, an Administrative Officer of the Government, an Information Officer of the Government, a police officer; or any other civil servant who is holding an office specified in the official capacity; or
- (iii) you have submitted an application to be registered as an ex-officio member as a holder of another specified office,

you may designate another person who is holding an office in a relevant body in relation to the specified office (“Designated Person”) to be registered as an ex-officio member. You may submit the application by completing the form **“Application by Designated Person / Council Chairman or Chairman of the Board of Governors of the relevant University for New Registration as Ex-Officio Members of Election Committee” (REO-EC(X3))**.

The form must be signed by both the specified person and the designated person; and

- (c) Each person may only be registered as an ex-officio member for one specified office.
