

Registration in the Architectural, Surveying, Planning and Landscape Functional Constituency (“FC”)

1. Who is eligible to be registered

You are eligible to be registered if you satisfy the requirements as set out in row (A) in the table below:

(A) Individuals eligible to register as electors	<p>(Section 20K of Cap. 542)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">(a) Architects registered under the Architects Registration Ordinance (Cap. 408);(b) Members of The Hong Kong Institute of Architects entitled to vote at general meetings of the Institute;(c) Landscape architects registered under the Landscape Architects Registration Ordinance (Cap. 516);(d) Members of The Hong Kong Institute of Landscape Architects entitled to vote at general meetings of the Institute;(e) Professional surveyors registered under the Surveyors Registration Ordinance (Cap. 417);(f) Members of The Hong Kong Institute of Surveyors entitled to vote at general meetings of the Institute;(g) Professional planners registered under the Planners Registration Ordinance (Cap. 418); or(h) Members of The Hong Kong Institute of Planners entitled to vote at general meetings of the Institute.

2. Points to note

- (a) If you meet the eligibilities for registration as described in Part 1, you may complete and submit the **“Functional Constituency Elector (Individual) Application for New Registration/Report on Change of Particulars” (REO-FC(I))** to apply for registration in this FC; and
- (b) To be eligible for registration as an individual elector for an FC, you must be registered or have applied to be so registered as an elector for a geographical constituency (“GC”). If you have not registered as an elector for a GC, please complete the **“Application for New Registration/Report on Change of Particulars by an Elector in a Geographical Constituency” (REO-GC)** and submit it together with your application.
