	(f) Hong Kong Special Administrative Region committee members of the All-China Youth Federation; or
	(g) Hong Kong Special Administrative Region directors of the China Overseas Friendship Association.

2. Points to note

- (a) If you meet the eligibilities for registration as described in Part 1, you may complete and submit the "Functional Constituency Elector (Individual) Application for New Registration/Report on Change of Particulars" (REO-FC(I)) to apply for registration in this FC; and
- (b) To be eligible for registration as an individual elector for an FC, you must be registered or have applied to be so registered as an elector for a geographical constituency ("GC"). If you have not registered as an elector for a GC, please complete the "Application for New Registration/Report on Change of Particulars by an Elector in a Geographical Constituency" (REO-GC) and submit it together with your application.
