

## **Registration in the Education Functional Constituency (“FC”)**

### **1. Who is eligible to be registered**

You are eligible to be registered if you satisfy the requirements as set out in row (A) in the table below:

<b>(A) Individuals eligible to register as electors</b>	<p>(Section 20E of Cap. 542)</p> <p>(a) Full-time academic staff engaged in teaching or research and administrative staff of equivalent rank in the following institutions–</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>(i) institutions of higher education funded through the University Grants Committee;</li><li>(ii) approved post secondary colleges registered under the Post Secondary Colleges Ordinance (Cap. 320);</li><li>(iii) technical colleges established under the Vocational Training Council Ordinance (Cap. 1130);</li><li>(iv) The Hong Kong Academy for Performing Arts; or</li><li>(v) the Hong Kong Metropolitan University;</li></ul> <p>(aa) Full-time academic staff engaged in teaching or research and administrative staff of equivalent rank in the institutions which–</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>(i) offer post secondary education leading to the award of any qualification entered into the Qualifications Register established under the Accreditation of Academic and Vocational Qualifications Ordinance (Cap. 592); and</li><li>(ii) are set up by –<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>(A) an institution of higher education funded through the University Grants Committee;</li><li>(B) The Hong Kong Academy for Performing Arts; or</li><li>(C) the Hong Kong Metropolitan University;</li></ul></li></ul> <p>(b) Members of each of the following bodies–</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>(i) Council of the University of Hong Kong;</li><li>(ii) Council of The Chinese University of Hong Kong;</li><li>(iii) Council of The Hong Kong University of Science and Technology;</li><li>(iv) Council of the City University of Hong Kong;</li><li>(v) Council of The Hong Kong Polytechnic University;</li><li>(vi) Council of The Hong Kong Academy for Performing Arts;</li><li>(vii) Council of the Hong Kong Metropolitan University;</li><li>(viii) the Vocational Training Council;</li><li>(ix) Council of The Education University of Hong Kong;</li><li>(x) Council of the Hong Kong Baptist University;</li><li>(xi) Council of Lingnan University; or</li><li>(xii) Board of Governors of post secondary colleges registered under the Post Secondary Colleges Ordinance (Cap. 320);</li></ul>

<p><b>(A)</b> <b>Individuals eligible to register as electors</b></p>	<p>(c) Registered teachers registered under the Education Ordinance (Cap. 279);</p> <p>(d) Permitted teachers engaged in full-time employment in schools registered or provisionally registered under the Education Ordinance (Cap. 279);</p> <p>(e) Teachers and principals of schools entirely maintained and controlled by the Government;</p> <p>(f) Persons whose principal or only employment is that of full-time teaching with the following institutions—</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>(i) technical institutes, industrial training centres or skills centres established under the Vocational Training Council Ordinance (Cap. 1130);</li><li>(ii) industrial training centres established under the repealed Industrial Training (Construction Industry) Ordinance (Cap. 317) and maintained under the Construction Industry Council Ordinance (Cap. 587);</li><li>(iia) industrial training centres established under the Construction Industry Council Ordinance (Cap. 587);</li><li>(iii) industrial training centres established under the Industrial Training (Clothing Industry) Ordinance (Cap. 318);</li><li>(iv) Hong Chi Association–Hong Chi Pinehill Integrated Vocational Training Centre; or</li><li>(v) Caritas Lok Mo Integrated Vocational Training Centre of Caritas–Hong Kong incorporated under the Caritas–Hong Kong Incorporation Ordinance (Cap. 1092); or</li></ul> <p>(g) Registered managers of schools registered under the Education Ordinance (Cap. 279).</p>

## 2. Points to note

- (a) If you meet the eligibilities for registration as described in Part 1, you may complete and submit the **“Functional Constituency Elector (Individual) Application for New Registration/Report on Change of Particulars” (REO-FC(I))** to apply for registration in this FC; and
- (b) To be eligible for registration as an individual elector for an FC, you must be registered or have applied to be so registered as an elector for a geographical constituency (“GC”). If you have not registered as an elector for a GC, please complete the **“Application for New Registration/Report on Change of Particulars by an Elector in a Geographical Constituency” (REO-GC)** and submit it together with your application.
