

Registration in the Engineering Functional Constituency (“FC”)

1. Who is eligible to be registered

You are eligible to be registered if you satisfy the requirements as set out in row (A) in the table below:

(A) Individuals eligible to register as electors	(Section 20J of Cap. 542) (a) Professional engineers registered under the Engineers Registration Ordinance (Cap. 409); or (b) Members of the Hong Kong Institution of Engineers entitled to vote at general meetings of the Institution.

2. Points to note

- (a) If you meet the eligibilities for registration as described in Part 1, you may complete and submit the **“Functional Constituency Elector (Individual) Application for New Registration/Report on Change of Particulars” (REO-FC(I))** to apply for registration in this FC; and
- (b) To be eligible for registration as an individual elector for an FC, you must be registered or have applied to be so registered as an elector for a geographical constituency (“GC”). If you have not registered as an elector for a GC, please complete the **“Application for New Registration/Report on Change of Particulars by an Elector in a Geographical Constituency” (REO-GC)** and submit it together with your application.
