Registration in the Social Welfare Functional Constituency ("FC")

1. Who is eligible to be registered

You are eligible to be registered if you satisfy the requirements as set out in row (A) in the table below:

(A)	(Section 20M of Cap. 542)
Individuals eligible to register as electors	Social workers registered under the Social Workers Registration Ordinance (Cap. 505).

2. Points to note

- (a) If you meet the eligibilities for registration as described in Part 1, you may complete and submit the "Functional Constituency Elector (Individual) Application for New Registration/Report on Change of Particulars" (REO-FC(I)) to apply for registration in this FC; and
- (b) To be eligible for registration as an individual elector for an FC, you must be registered or have applied to be so registered as an elector for a geographical constituency ("GC"). If you have not registered as an elector for a GC, please complete the "Application for New Registration/Report on Change of Particulars by an Elector in a Geographical Constituency" (REO-GC) and submit it together with your application.
