

## Registration in the Social Welfare Functional Constituency (“FC”)

### 1. Who is eligible to be registered

You are eligible to be registered if you satisfy the requirements as set out in row (A) in the table below:

<b>(A) Individuals eligible to register as electors</b>	(Section 20M of Cap. 542)  Social workers registered under the Social Workers Registration Ordinance (Cap. 505).

### 2. Points to note

- (a) If you meet the eligibilities for registration as described in Part 1, you may complete and submit the **“Functional Constituency Elector (Individual) Application for New Registration/Report on Change of Particulars” (REO-FC(I))** to apply for registration in this FC; and
- (b) To be eligible for registration as an individual elector for an FC, you must be registered or have applied to be so registered as an elector for a geographical constituency (“GC”). If you have not registered as an elector for a GC, please complete the **“Application for New Registration/Report on Change of Particulars by an Elector in a Geographical Constituency” (REO-GC)** and submit it together with your application.
